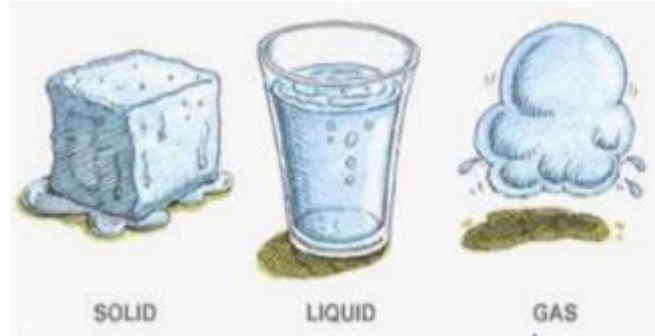


Key Vocabulary	
Trinity	God is one but made up of 3 equal parts
God the Father	God who lives in Heaven and created the world
God the Son	Known as Jesus who came to earth to die on the cross and now lives in Heaven
God the Spirit	Known as the holy Spirit or the Holy Ghost
The Holy Spirit	Christians believe the Holy Spirit lives within them guiding and helping them
Baptism	A religious sign of being washed clean with water. An outward sign of being a Christian
Pentecost	The descent of the Holy Spirit and the Christian church's mission to the world

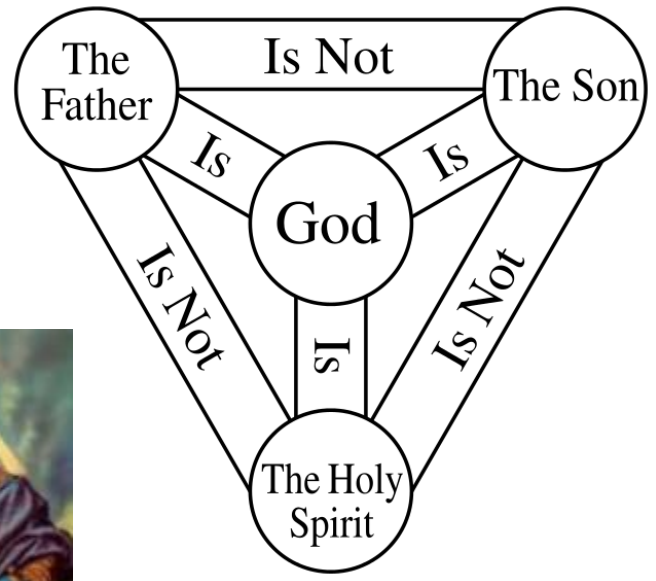
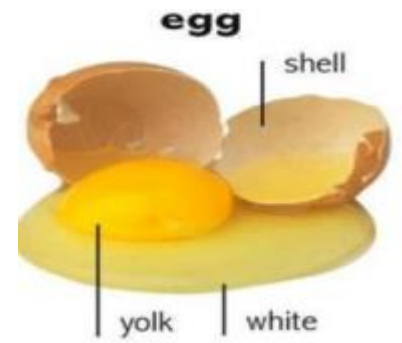


How are each of the 3 parts of the trinity different?

Key Knowledge	
<p>Christians believe God is Trinity: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Christians believe the Father creates; he sends the Son who saves his people; the Son sends the Holy Spirit to his followers. Jesus, the Son of God, is seen by Christians as revealing what God the Father is like. Understanding God is challenging; people spend their whole lives learning more and more about God. Christians believe the Holy Spirit is God's power at work in the world and in their lives today, enabling them to follow Jesus.
